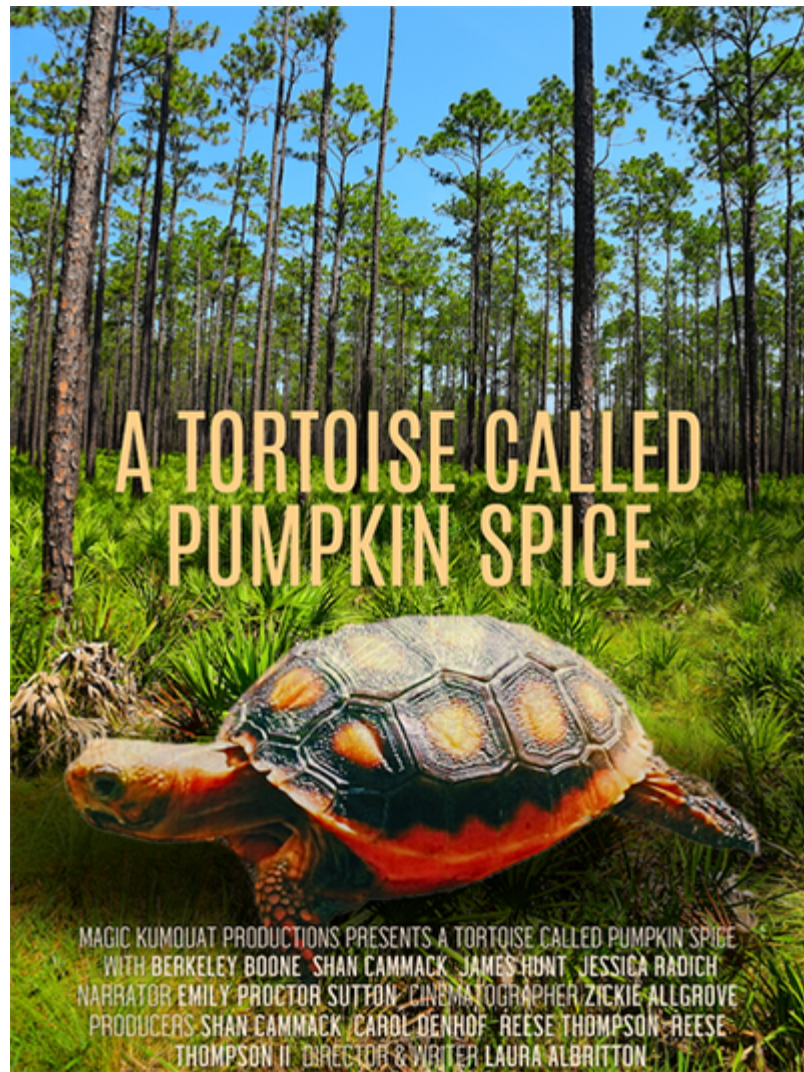


Thursday, Sept. 12
